

REMINDERS AS WE HEAD INTO LENT:

<u>FASTING</u> means that we do not eat between meals and that our two smaller meals taken together do not exceed the quantity taken at the one full meal. This obligation is only for those from age 18 to 59 and is required only on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday.

ABSTINENCE: All of those age 14 and older are obliged to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday, the Fridays of Lent, and Good Friday. This is in honor of Jesus' dying on Friday and has been a traditional form of penance for many centuries.






