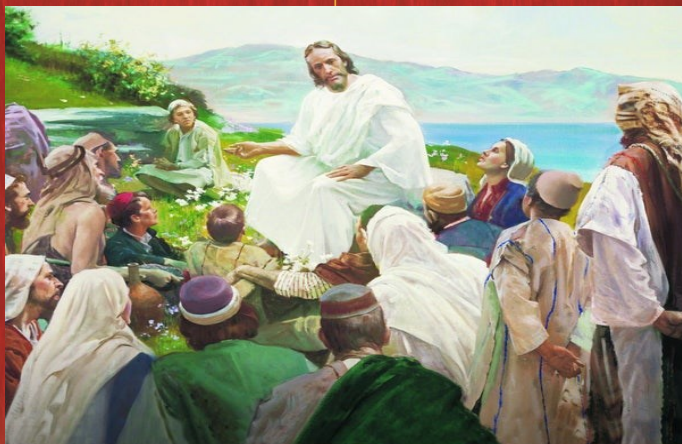

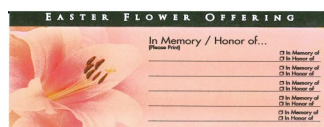

### REMINDERS AS WE HEAD INTO LENT:

**FASTING** means that we do not eat between meals and that our two smaller meals taken together do not exceed the quantity taken at the one full meal. This obligation is only for those from age 18 to 59 and is required only on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday.

**ABSTINENCE:** All of those age 14 and older are obliged to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday, the Fridays of Lent, and Good Friday. This is in honor of Jesus' dying on Friday and has been a traditional form of penance for many centuries.

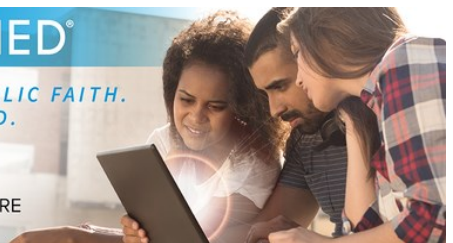

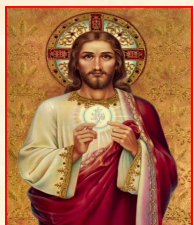


**Our sisters and brothers who are in need should be in our hearts because they are in God's heart.**

We must share, shelter, clothe, and be attentive to the vulnerable among us because they belong to us, as they belong to God. I may have written here before that one of the most striking talks I have encountered was given by Sr. Elinor Ford about twenty-five years ago. In it, she said, "I belong to God and God needs me." Don't mistake me, it is not as though God is a needy, distant deity who uses us as pawns in a game. Rather, God needs us to act as Christ's people in the world because, as St. Teresa of Avila put it so well, "Christ has no body now on earth but yours."



Saint Ignatius of Loyola offered us these words of wisdom, which seem particularly relevant as we come closer to the season of Lent: "He who goes about to reform the world must begin with himself, or he loses his labor."

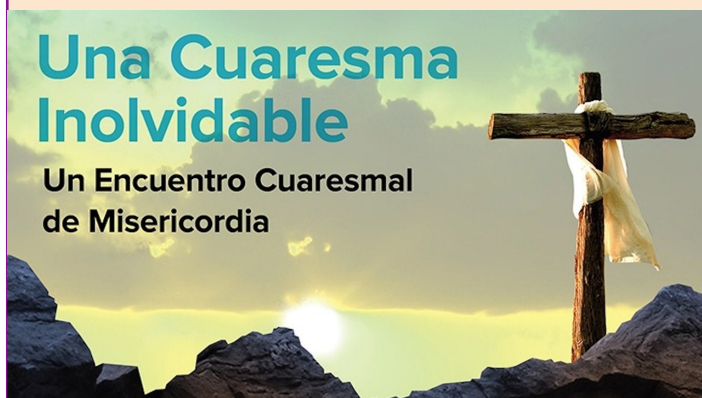
