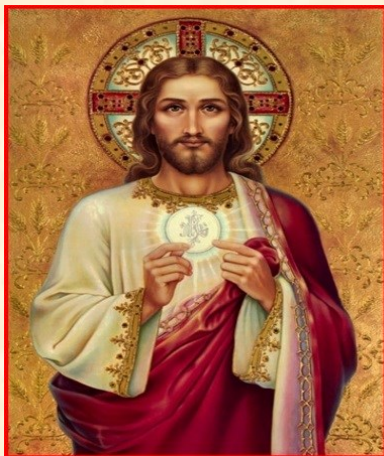

THE YEAR OF ST. JOSEPH INDULGENCES

Granted by the Holy See from December 8, 2020 to December 8, 2021

Below is a summary of how you can receive the special indulgences granted by the Holy See for the Year of St. Joseph.

The plenary indulgence is granted under the usual conditions (sacramental confession, Eucharistic communion and prayer according to the intentions of the Holy Father) to the faithful who, with a spirit detached from any sin, participate in the Year of Saint Joseph on the occasions and in the manner indicated by this Apostolic Penitentiary:

Meditate for at least 30 minutes on the Our Father. Participate in a spiritual retreat of at least one day that includes a meditation on Saint Joseph. Perform a corporal or spiritual work of mercy. Recite the Holy Rosary in families and between the husband and wife. Entrust their work daily to the protection of Saint Joseph and to all believers who invoke with their prayers the intercession of the worker of Nazareth. Pray the litany of Saint Joseph (for the Latin tradition) in its entirety or at least part of it (for the Byzantine tradition), or some other prayer to Saint Joseph, typical of the other liturgical traditions, for the persecuted Church and for the relief of all persecuted Christians. Pray any lawfully approved prayer or act of piety in honor of Saint Joseph, for example "To you oh blessed Joseph," especially on March 19 (Solemnity of St. Joseph), May 1 (Feast of St. Joseph the Worker), December 26. (Feast of the Holy Family), The Sunday of Saint Joseph (according to the Byzantine tradition), the 19 day of every month, and every Wednesday (a day dedicated to the memory of the Saint according to the Latin tradition).

The gift of plenary indulgence extends particularly to the elderly, the sick, the dying, and all those who for legitimate reasons cannot leave their home.

St. Vincent de Paul is running out of funds and is asking for monetary donations, as well as gift cards from superstores like Walmart and Target.

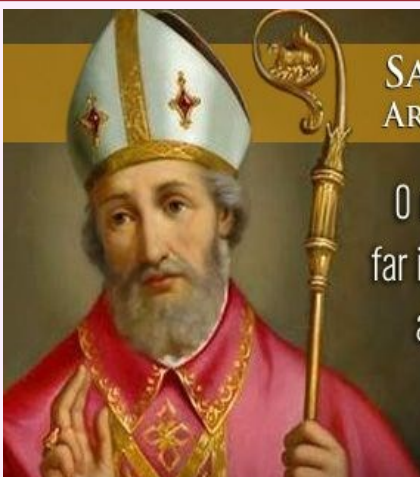

AROUND THE ARCHDIOCESE



ATLANTA—On March 31, Archbishop Gregory J. Hartmayer, OFM Conv., offered a statement on racism, pledging a personal commitment to model the change that must take place to eradicate the sin.

“We have all witnessed in the past year a resurgence of the sin of racism. This insidious evil—our country’s original sin—has resurfaced in our modern, socially distanced lives, causing further division between families, friends, and faith communities. More importantly, sisters and brothers of color continue to suffer from both overt and systemic expressions of this sin, often feeling intense anger and great disappointment in the failure to condemn and eradicate racism in our country.

The U.S. Bishops were clear in the 2018 pastoral letter on racism, *Open Wide Our Hearts: The Enduring Call to Love*, stating that ‘Racist acts are sinful because they violate justice. They reveal a failure to acknowledge the human dignity of the persons offended, to recognize them as the neighbors Christ calls us to love (Mt 22:39).’ Our words affirm what God has revealed to us: the sin of racism is not an expression of love and we cannot truly love God and allow racism to continue to thrive and separate us as brethren united in Christ.

As your shepherd, I confess and own the fact that racism exists both individually and structurally in our own archdiocesan Chancery, in our parishes and in our schools. To those who have experienced racism, I care deeply about what has happened to you and I apologize for our failure to condemn the violation of your human dignity. It grieves me to know that I cannot undo the harm that has been done. It is my hope that my apology for the sins of our past can serve as a prologue for our path forward towards healing and reconciliation.

I commit myself to personally modeling the change that must take place, ensuring you that I support the work of eradicating the sin of racism at all levels in this local church. I commit myself to modeling change through the gift of encounter, where the ignorance and fear of the other is dispelled through mutual recognition and respect of our shared human dignity. I also commit to prioritizing the celebration of all our diverse communities in the archdiocese through measures promoting the intercultural competency development of ministry leaders in our communities and institutions.

I humbly ask you, sisters and brothers, to pray for me, your bishops and our local church in the spirit of the prophetic words Micah: Through the intercession of our Blessed Mother and St. Joseph, may we do ‘... what is good, and what the Lord requires of [us]: only to do justice and to love goodness, and to walk humbly with [our] God.’ (Mi 6:8)
May God bless us, guide us and keep us on our journey together in eradicating the sin of racism.”

En el último año todos hemos sido testigos de la reaparición del pecado del racismo. Este mal insidioso, el pecado original de nuestro país, ha resurgido en nuestras vidas modernas y socialmente distanciadas, provocando una mayor división entre las familias, los amigos y las comunidades de fe. Más importante aún, nuestras hermanas y hermanos de color continúan sufriendo expresiones tanto evidentes como sistémicas de este pecado, a menudo sintiendo una rabia intensa y una gran decepción por la incapacidad para condenar y erradicar el racismo en nuestro país.

Los Obispos de los Estados Unidos fueron claros en la carta pastoral de 2018 contra el racismo, Abramos nuestros corazones: El incesante llamado al amor, afirmando que “los actos racistas son pecaminosos porque violan la justicia. Revelan que no se reconoce la dignidad humana de las personas ofendidas, que no se las reconoce como el prójimo al que Cristo nos llama a amar (Mt. 22, 39)”. Nuestras palabras afirman lo que Dios nos ha revelado: el pecado del racismo no es una expresión de amor y no podemos amar verdaderamente a Dios y permitir que el racismo continúe prosperando y separándonos como hermanos unidos en Cristo.

Como su pastor, confieso y reconozco el hecho de que el racismo existe tanto individual como estructuralmente en nuestra propia cancellería arquidiocesana, en nuestras parroquias y en nuestras escuelas. Me preocupa profundamente lo que le haya sucedido a aquellos que han experimentado racismo, y me disculpo por nuestra incapacidad para haber condenado la violación de su dignidad como seres humanos. Me entristece saber que no puedo reparar el daño que se ha hecho. Espero que mi disculpa por los pecados de nuestro pasado pueda servir como prólogo para nuestro camino hacia la sanación y la reconciliación.

Me comprometo a modelar personalmente el cambio que debe tener lugar, asegurándole a todos que apoyo el trabajo de erradicar el pecado del racismo en todos los niveles de esta Iglesia local. Me comprometo a modelar el cambio a través del don del encuentro, donde la ignorancia y el miedo al otro se disipa a través del respeto y el reconocimiento mutuos de la dignidad humana que compartimos. También me comprometo a dar prioridad a la celebración de las diversas comunidades de nuestra arquidiócesis a través de medidas que promuevan el desarrollo de la competencia intercultural de los líderes ministeriales de nuestras comunidades e instituciones.

Humildemente les pido, hermanas y hermanos, que oren por mí, por sus obispos y por nuestra Iglesia local en el espíritu de las palabras proféticas de Miqueas: A través de la intercesión de nuestra Santísima Madre y San José, para que hagamos “... lo bueno y qué exige de [nosotros] el Señor: nada más que practicar la justicia, amar la fidelidad y caminar humildemente con [nuestro] Dios”. (Miqueas 6: 8)

Que Dios nos bendiga, nos guíe y nos mantenga en nuestro camino juntos para erradicar el pecado del racismo.

**San Anselmo de
Canterbury**

Arzobispo y doctor
de la Iglesia

San Anselmo de Canterbury O.S.B. (Aosta, 1033 - Canterbury, 1109). Se le conoce también como Anselmo de Aosta, por el lugar donde nació, o Anselmo de Bec, si se atiende a la población donde estaba enclavado el monasterio del cual llegó a ser prior. Fue un monje benedictino que fungió como arzobispo de Canterbury durante el periodo 1093-1109. Destacó como teólogo y filósofo escolástico. Doctor de la Iglesia.
